Principal's Report - Josh Griffin

What's happening at D'Evelyn?

- Pivot to remote only through November 20, 2020
- D'Evelyn 6th grade students attending Outdoor Lab this week
- D'Evelyn seniors completed SAT (October 27th) and juniors PSAT (October 29th)

Pivot to remote learning:

- Due to the number of positive cases, contacts, and quarantines, we made the difficult decision to close school for in-person learning through November 20th.
- We plan to return to in-person learning after Thanksgiving Break on November 30th.
- Due to the lack of contact between our 6th grade students/teachers and positive individuals, we were able to continue with Outdoor Lab this week.
- Ultimately, we believe that this decision best protects the health/safety of all community members and ensures us the opportunity to continue to provide quality learning experiences for our students.
- Modified bell schedule for remote learning, effective Wednesday 11/11/2020 schedule will run through the duration of any remote learning periods this semester.

Covid-19 updates:

- Rise in cases, positivity rates, and hospitalizations continues.
- Jeffco Schools continues to review and monitor the situation to ultimately make determinations about whether schools can/will remain open.
- As of today, we have reverted to the earlier quarantine process, which does not include a review to determine close contacts in the academic setting.

2nd Semester Schedule:

- Four primary changes, in effective January 6, 2021:
 - o Remove "soft start" from 1st period
 - o Move 7th hour to the end of the day
 - o Switch rotational schedule from AABB to ABAB
 - o Allow students to attend 7th hour remotely
- Overall rationale for these four changes:
 - o More practical and responsive to need
 - o Reduces additional, non-academic time throughout the day
 - o Increase efficiency of available time for students & faculty
 - o ABAB rotation is a more natural distribution of content for learning
 - o Split feedback on the early dismissal option
- Conditions:
 - o This plan is built for the continuation of remote and hybrid learning models.
 - If we are fully remote during the 2nd semester, we will follow a different schedule
 - If we are fully in-person in the 2nd semester, we will likely follow a different schedule
 - o Sign up for the semester using 2nd semester preference survey by November 20th.

6th Grade Addition & Building Improvements:

- Design Advisory Committee has met twice and will meet a third time this week
- The new wing addition will be located on the NE side of the building and include 8 classrooms. Current plan:
 - o 4 standard classrooms
 - o 2 classrooms equipped for science
 - o 1 art room
 - o 1 new fitness room
 - o Current fitness room will be converted to a music room
- This plan supports the needs of our 6th grade students and high enrollment interest throughout our program for Art, Music and PE.
- D'Evelyn bond work (as approved by Jeffco voters in 2018) and other needed structural improvements will begin soon, including:
 - o Replacing damaged sections of the roof
 - o Replacing floor in cafeteria
 - o Addressing other floor settlement issues

Honors Update

- As mentioned last meeting, S/C voted to proceed with CU-06, with the addition of a district-approved waiver to change the grading scale for Honors coursework.
- District leadership has approved the waiver for 2 years, in accordance with district policy CEB:
 - o Waiver valid from August 1, 2021 July 31, 2023.
- Next steps:
 - o Construct teams to review proposed Honors courses.
 - o Collaborate with the school district on setting this grading scale up on the tech side.
- We intend to complete course reviews prior to end of the 2020-2021 school year.

- o Developing a survey to collect data regarding 6th Grade.
 - Will submit draft for approval.
- o Next meeting will discuss academic and social student logistics, extra-curricular activities, and collect feedback.
- Technology & Remote Learning (Bill Kottenstette)
 - Will meet 6 times with the following plan:
 - 1st 3 months remote learning
 - Months 4 and 5 technology/cell phone
 - Month 6 final check-in on remote learning
 - O Determine recommendations to A/C for implementation.

 - Urged community to contact Steering Committee to request online voting for 2021 elections, to allow for maximum parent participation during Covid times.
- Lisa Cushnie:
 - o Re-iterated informing A/C and parents regarding the Steering Committee's decision to vote for walk-in only ballots for 2021 Steering Committee election.
 - Moving to electronic voting, would allow for greater voter turnout and encourages parent involvement.
