Principal's Report – Josh Griffin

- Celebrations

- 3rd week of our Return to Hybrid
- Budget Plans for 2021-2022:
 - Addition of 1 new counselor
 - Addition of at least 1 new full-time teacher (JRHS English/History combo)
- 2021-2022 School Year
 - District Plan was distributed to all Jeffco families on Thursday 2/4
 - Students will be either:
 - o 100% remote (central online school)
 - o 100% in-person
 - Unique D'Evelyn liberal arts curriculum
 - D'Evelyn Plan targets:
 - Offer distinct courses for both remote and in-person students
 - o Eliminate "bimodal" instruction
 - o Intend to provide remote-only option on a year-long basis with the intent of providing that option to students with individual or family health concerns
 - We have a lot of planning and adjustment to make to bring this to reality
 - One planned adjustment increase 6th grade enrollment from 90 students to 115 students in 2021-2022
- Budget Planning shifting instructional modalities will necessitate adjustments to staffing/funding to support remote and in-person students next year
- Honor Course Review Update
 - Teacher course reviews wrapping up due February 16th
 - Honors Review Committee will review these reports

 - Developing schedule to test students:
 - o Grade 6 ELA & Math

 - o Grade 8 ELA, Math, & Science
 - o Grade 11 Science
 - Finalizing schedule options
 - On testing days, we are planning for non-testing students to have remote classes
 - Some CMAS testing will occur on Fridays
- SAT & PSAT
 - SAT April 13th (remote only day for grades 6-10, 12)
 - PSAT 9 & 10 April 16th

- AP Testing College Board recently released guidance and we are developing a plan for D'Evelyn
- Hiring Updates:
 - Starting to build hiring committees for 2021-2022
 - Dana Miller, S/C chair, will reach out to parent volunteers to serve these committees; those that have attended hiring training in the past few years are eligible to serve in hiring committees this year
