### Return to 100% In-Person Learning

- Very successful first 1 ½ weeks back in the in-person learning model
- Great energy and enthusiasm from students and teachers
- We are grateful to our students, staff, and families for their seamless adjustment
- We continue to emphasize the importance of health/safety precautions an increase in cases can cause more limitations on athletic/extracurricular events as well as basis school operations
- It is our goal to stay open through the end of the school year and to avoid cancelling any events

# 100% Remote Option in 2021-2022

- Final survey for feedback distributed today
- Based on interest back in March, it is very unlikely that we will be able to offer even a very limited remoteonly option next year
- With overall improvement in Covid-19 conditions, and increased distribution of vaccine, we are encouraged by the environment projected in Fall 2021 for the new school year
- We emphasize the critical importance of in-person learning opportunities
- We will work with individual families with unique needs and support those that may seek to attend school elsewhere

- Determined a need to increase 6th grade program in size to 4 class sections for 2021-2022 school year

- So far, applications and interviews have gone well talented individuals interested in working at D'Evelyn **Building**
- Jeffco BOE approved the funding for the D'Evelyn building addition to be completed between May 2021 August 2022 for the new wing to support the addition of the 6th grade program
- Additionally, we will undergo renovations of the current instrumental music classroom as part of this process
