- The counselors discussed the roles they play in the main areas of academics, social/emotional wellbeing and career/college planning
- ICAP is given in Junior High (both 7th and 8th grades)
- Junior High updates include: counseling needs assessment, overcoming text anxiety presentations, boys mentoring, NJHS
- High School has 2 counselors that have dedicated and shared duties
- High School duties include AP Coordination, Career Exploration, ACT/SAT preparation, college rep visits, junior escorts for graduation, jag tracks articles, college night, district high school committee
- January 5th is the date for the practice ACT
- ICAP is given in 9th grade and reviewed each following year to discuss issues involving college and career goals
- High School updates include: 9th grade transition day, counseling needs assessment, partnership with College Drive (ACT Prep), highly selective small group for seniors, Sources of Strength (program for student support based on peer to peer interaction that will be implemented next school year), April college night open to all grades, coffee with counselors

 of the presentation will need to be explored further.

Principal Report – Tony Edwards

- Building construction update: the scope of work has been reduced. Therefore, the school will no longer be shut down for the entire summer. The chiller will be replaced which will impact athletics over the summer (The project will begin the week after school is out for summer).
- Prep school will continue as normal
- Location of summer school programs will be determined at a later date
- Budget update: this year junior high students are funded at the junior high level which
 increases the funding for these students over last year when they were funded at the
 same level as high school students.
- On December 18th the school will receive its budget and updates to A/C will be provided after that date. Any reductions or excesses will be discussed.
- D'Evelyn Phone App: former teacher (computer) is working on this app. It will include calendar, daily announcements, contact info for staff, etc... Test phase will begin when we return from winter break. If everything is working correctly then it will be sent out to the entire community after a few weeks of testing.
- Fall sports have officially ended. Winter sports are starting.
- This week is concert week (choir, band, orchestra)
- 2014/2015 8th Grade Survey results were presented to A/C this year and Senior High Survey results will be presented early next semester.

Steering Committee Report (S/C) – Lisa Papke

- Candidate Information meeting followed the November A/C meeting and there was a good turnout for interested candidates.
- Those interested in running for election of open Steering positions will need to submit their application by the deadline of February 16, 2016 at 3:00 in the Main office Steering Chair's box.

- Founder and Emeritus meeting will be held in January following the A/C meeting on January 12, 2016 at 6:45 p.m We encourage all community members to attend and learn from the Founders and Emeritus historical information regarding the school and how best to protect our program.
- Curricular reviews completed: AP Spanish/ AP Psych/ AP Chemistry/ AP Art. Next semester we will begin three more existing course reviews.
- Algebra Basics Skills course will be eliminated from the course selection starting fall 2016.
- SC approved several beginning option to use Virtual Academy for credit recovery options.
